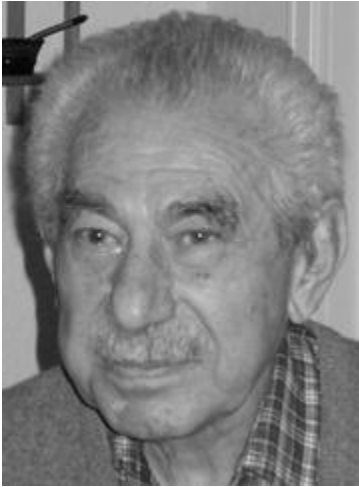


OBITUARY

Julius London, Boulder

1917 - 2009



Julius London of Boulder died of natural causes on Wednesday, February 25, 2009. The son of Phillip and Sadie (Weinberger) London, he was born on March 26, 1917 in Newark, New Jersey. He married Dorothy Sibulsky on July 6, 1946 in Chicago, Illinois. Julius moved to Boulder in 1961.

He earned a BS from Brooklyn College and a Ph. D. from New York University. He was a professor of meteorology and atmospheric science at NYU, the University of Colorado and ETH in Zurich. He presented his research at many conferences in North America, Europe, and Asia. His research on radiation transfer in the earth's atmosphere has served as a basis for recent studies of global climate change.

Julius was an active hiker and skier for much of his life. He was a loving and devoted husband to Dorothy, father to David and Richard, father-in-law to Judith, and grandfather to Shoshana and Anna. He had many friends and was loved by many.

He was preceded in death by his wife Dorothy and son David.

A memorial service will be held at 10:00 am, Monday, March 2 in the Chapel at Frazier Meadows, 4840 Thunderbird Drive, Boulder. The burial will be at 10:00 am, Tuesday, March 3 at Green Mountain Cemetery, Boulder.
